Quizlet has become a powerful tool in language learning due to its innovative approach. It is a U.S.-based multilingual company that provides learning tools and resources. Quizlet was founded in October 2005 by Andrew Sutherland, who was just 15 years old at the time, as a means to study for his French class. The platform was publicly launched in January 2007. Quizlet offers digital flashcards, customizable games, interactive quizzes, and electronic assessments that are widely used by learners and educators worldwide. By 2017, one out of every two high school students in the U.S. had used Quizlet. As of December 2021, the platform contained over 500 million user-generated flashcard sets and had more than 60 million active users globally. In an online interview on Reddit, Sutherland explained that during the first six months, he was experimenting with the tool himself, but after gaining interest from around 100 users, he decided to make it public. To manage business aspects, he established a company called Brainflare with his father acting as financial director. Quizlet's blog, mostly written by Sutherland in its early days, claims that the site reached 50,000 registered users within 252 days of going live (September 26, 2007). Within the next two years, Quizlet reached its one-millionth registered user. Although the platform faced several challenges in its early development, it continued to grow steadily.

Another effective tool that has gained attention is the World Draw interactive method.

World Draw is a web-based interactive platform developed by Google. It allows users to create simple 2D drawings and convert them into 3D objects using artificial intelligence. Presented at the 2019 Google I/O conference, the project aims to foster creative collaboration by recognizing users' drawings and integrating them into an



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expanding virtual world. While primarily designed as a creative and technological experiment, World Draw can be effectively used in language education. For example:

- **Language Learning:** Students can describe the objects they draw in English, either verbally or in writing, thereby expanding their vocabulary;
- **Creative Thinking:** Expressing ideas through sketches supports the development of students' imaginative and analytical skills;
- **Collaborative Learning:** It encourages teamwork and group communication during class activities.

This article primarily focuses on the pedagogical effectiveness of the Quizlet platform in language teaching, highlighting how such tools can be integrated into lessons to enhance learner engagement and educational outcomes.

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2. Discussion and Results

The use of the Quizlet platform in the language learning process enables teachers to organize online lessons tailored to learners' proficiency levels across different classes. New vocabulary relevant to each level can be uploaded and visually represented in an organized format. Within the platform, tools such as "Blitz," "Matching Words," and "Flashcards" allow students to learn the material more quickly and efficiently. These game-based learning modes are especially effective for revision lessons, helping to reinforce previously taught material and improve vocabulary retention.

The integration of Quizlet into classroom instruction has demonstrated the following benefits for learners:

- It effectively reinforces learners' acquired knowledge, supporting long-term retention;
- It helps develop collaborative learning skills by encouraging students to work in groups;
- Unlike traditional methods, it fosters independent learning, providing students with more control over their progress;
- It promotes a friendly and cooperative environment among learners;
- It allows educators to track learners' individual progress periodically, making it easier to identify strengths and areas for improvement;
- It significantly enhances learners' motivation and interest in learning a foreign language.
